Sir Isaac Newton to the Group 7/7/06 read out

If there is one God, why do you personally there is so much division, all claiming that they have the only God, the fast track to God?

Vivienne: Its division is in the nature of God. Each division has a different idea of what God IS and IS NOT, and different ways of expressing "what God is". People who relate to that culture or religion hold fast to that belief, seeking external answers to the truth.

Leanne: The more "out of touch" with the sacred feminine energy, the more likely we are to loose touch with subtleties and look for more black and white. With that comes being more reliant on external authorities, we loose the ability to think for ourselves and then get caught up in the symantics.

Virginia: Agrees with the previous people. It is a separation from the sacred feminine and also God. This is where fear comes in and the need for power. Fear is the opposite of God. People gain power from being in a group, they feel safe.

Jordie: (11 year old male) People are scared of dying, so they want to believe there is a God, so they go to religion. Jordie shared feelings of being worried... if his spirituality was shown and shared, he may be treated differently and judged for thinking and feeling differently, even though it feels right to him. So he suppresses this information, and does not tell other people.

Michelle: With becoming part of a religion, there is a connection point. People want to have a mental understanding. Religions offer this, but through one specific religion you only see one side of the diamond and you limit seeing the full diamond in all its glory.

Kim: Perhaps when people make a connection with a religion, there is this undeniable spark within....(likely the soul saying....yes!...that's right...there is a God..etc) To the person this feeling/spark is so intense...It does feel right!!! Perhaps people then make the connection of the "right feeling" with the religion and then tend to believe that all from that religion is infallible. No other religion could be right... because I got that feeling/spark with "this" religion so I/we are right...others wrong!

Vivienne: The soul seeking, gains powerful emotion, it feels right, but emotions then seek external, religion or path that may hold answers...and then it continues from there.

Sir Isaac asks Jordie:

Question: How do you feel when you are really excited about something to do with God and then you suppress it?

Answer: Really, really happy, like a flame in my stomach. Then I clench my wrists and it all gets pushed down.

That is your power centre when and where you feel that flame. It is your guidance centre.

Sir Isaac asks Jordie:

Question: Would you feel happy if they rejected you?

Answer: I don't think I would feel as let down as I normally would.

Isaac: Taking the new line that discovery of new knowledge is interesting and growth inspiring, how do you keep your personal knowledge growing? How do you grow?

Michelle: Recognise you may never have all the answers and it is better to be open to all.
