What Is Truth? Discussion leads to these conclusions.

- * Truth is what you believe to be right
- * Truth means different things to different people
- * Truth is personal interpretation

Can Truth Evolve?

- * Each Person's truth can; the essence of truth needs to come from a clear space
- * Ultimate truth is incorruptible
- * There are truths that are inherent
- * As human consciousness evolves so too does the capacity to see and understand deeper truth.

What Does Truth Mean To You Personally?

V 2: (Response to J) I think we have just heard truth; which is being able to say "I don't know".

Is The Truth Where Your Soul Should Be Heading? – Soul Purpose

All in agreement - Yes

- * Feel all is in harmony if following the truth – the soul purpose.
- * Soul in harmony with God and Love. God connection – common path way.
- * Slight difference in interpretations.
- * No internal conflict if following soul purpose.
- * Highest truth, has to be love – the soul is always coming from love.

How Can The Sacred Feminine Be Restored

J: Big media coverage on newspapers and on TV

G: (Response to J)) But that is advertising

J: Yes, but we need to make people know, and lots of people read and watch TV; we need them to know the strengths of men and women, that women are gentle and men are strong. Like boys grow up; and have sort of a leading role and don't cry, but can protect you and girls are very caring and give lots of love. Sometimes gay men are a bit more like girls with gentle hearts.

G: Perhaps we need to start more in schools through education. Even around the world; women are unable to express themselves. Example: Women in Islamic countries are restricted by dress code.

V 2: Almost all countries around the globe restrict women to what they should and shouldn't do.

V 2: Perhaps it can be restored on a higher level, and what we are doing now is restoring the sacred feminine, and also balance. If everyone looks at their thought patterns and where they are dominating others thoughts and behaviour and make efforts to change, we are told it lifts the whole.

V 1: I think it can be restored through energy and the change of energies.

What Is The Sacred Feminine?

V 1: I see it as the quiet power

Power issuing from the softer, side of the heart

It's the opposite of the physical strength (that being the outer strength)

More the inner qualities of strength.

Embracing the emotions and life from an open heart.

G: Each person is a sacred person, makes no difference if they are male or female – more related to the approach to life. More the ability to think, rationalise and reason. As opposed to more male physical action (doing)

K: Would like to make the point that in bringing the feminine more into focus the importance of not devaluing the male, believes that there is a possibility of over compensating the feminine and in doing so again would take us out of balance.

V 2: It's the concept of balance; the original souls that were created were co-creators; male and female. There is no competition, just pure love, honouring, respect of each energy; giving perfect balance. This balance has been lost in favour of the masculinity only, and in doing so have become more vulnerable and have lost the emotional stability to deliver love unconditionally.

How Did She Loose Her Position?

V 2: In early times there was always a female counterpart; over time and from many different areas I.E. Religion, politics etc., the feminine disappeared or suppressed and was purposely excluded for male power and control. (Others in agreement)

V 2: I feel I have more right to express my opinions now than when I was younger. So I guess its conditional. I Am definitely more confident in expressing my opinions now.

J: I can with some people, but not with everyone because I don't think that they will understand.

K: Yes, I have the right to express my opinion to others, but its my own fear that stops me to expressing my opinion to all.
